I would like to introduce you to a tool that has worked for us in the OSHub project, mainly in terms of linking computer skills with outdoor activities.

This tool – we call it Eduard – is used to create mobile geolocation apps for smartphones. We put our own content, such as texts, images, audio recordings, videos, or 3D animations, into a simple web editor on a computer, which then processes them into an application for Android and iOS operating systems.

The result is an interactive mobile trail – in the field, when we approach a point of interest, the point is activated on the map on the smartphone and we can start working with it – viewing documents or completing interactive tasks.

Kids enjoy it a lot. They actually become creators of mobile applications and, at the same time, they learn when they prepare the materials together.
